Information YOU Need to Know!

- Sunday, June 26 arrive at GABC at 10.30 pm to load We will depart at 11 pm.
- We are traveling to camp via Charter Bus.
- Please no unnecessary electronics (IPads, Kindles, Computers...) You may bring your phone, but if it becomes a problem it will be removed from your possession until the trip home. If your toothbrush is electric, please bring it!
- We (GSM) are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Cell Phones If they become a problem they will be removed from your possession until the trip home. Josh and your adult chaperones will be the ones who decide when a problem has become a problem.
- Parents you will receive 2 phone calls during the week, as well as multiple updates via social media including pictures while your student is at camp.
- Please be on time to departure, you will be left!
- Camp is in Winter Park, Colorado where we are staying at the Vintage Hotel.
- Altitude sickness is a very real issue, please encourage your student to drink A LOT of water while at camp.
- You will receive more information about some awesome additional activities when we get a bit closer - but think white water rafting, zip lining and mountain biking!
- You will continue to receive information as final plans take shape! Be on the look out!

- 3. Balance is due June 12
- 4. Your Student will be responsible for buying 4 fast food meals while we travel (2 going to camp and 2 coming home)
