Today is Columbus Day - not Christopher Columbus, but Columbus, Ohio! Three years ago our church embarked upon a journey to partner with the North American Mission Board to plant churches in Columbus, Ohio. We made a number of commitments, one of which was to plant our own church there. We now have Access Church! Mark and Christi Cox continue to plow hard ground to plant a church in the Dublin/Powell area of northwest Columbus. Another commitment that we made was to bring other churches on board to support planting efforts in the city. Just a few weeks ago Brad, Don, and Scott hosted a thrid vision tour in Columbus for pastors all over the US to come and check out Columbus and see how they can get involved.

Another big commitment that we made was to give \$50,000 over 5 years to church planting in Columbus. We are a little over halfway through our time commitment, and we are about halfway to our financial goal. We are asking every member today to prayerfully consider what you might give to make a difference in a city where lostness abounds.
